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## NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

### MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW VALLEY CENTER REGION

The San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) invites all interested parties to review and provide comment on a draft municipal service review prepared on the Valley Center region. The draft municipal service review is specific to addressing the availability, need, and performance of public services provided in the region by (a) Valley Center Municipal Water District, (b) Valley Center Fire Protection District, and (c) Valley Center Community Services District relative to LAFCO's growth management interests and duties. This includes preparing determinative statements addressing all of the factors required under statute as part of the municipal service review mandate and headlined by population estimates, infrastructure needs, and financial standing.

The draft municipal service review includes an Executive Summary outlining key conclusions and recommendations identified to date by LAFCO staff. This includes – and among other items – recommending the Valley Center Community Services District and its park and recreation services be reorganized into a dependent County Service Area governed by the County of San Diego and the Board of Supervisors. It is similarly recommended the Valley Center Community Services District and County consider filing a joint-proposal to initiate the reorganization and realignment of park and recreation services in the region.
